Anderson Esq^r of Pendleton County was presented to the Office
and Recorded this 23rd day of June A D 1795

South Carolina, This Indenture of three parts made
the Tenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and ninety five and in the nineteenth year of
the sovereignty and Independance of the United States of
America between Thomas Farrar of the County of Pendleton
in the District of Washington in the State of South Carolina
Esquire, and high Sheriff of the aforesaid District of Washington,
of the first part, Charles Goodwin of the Village of Cambridge
in the County of Abbeville and District of Ninety six in the
said State Esquire Advocate and Counsellor of Law of the se-
cond part, and William Nibbs of the Village of Cambridge afo-
said a Trustee nominated by and on behalf of the said Charles
Goodwin of the third part Whereas his Excellency William Moultrie
Esq^r late Governor and Commander in chief in and over the said
State on the fourth day of August in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and ninety four, and in the nineteenth
year of the Sovereignty, and Independance of the United States
of America did in and by Twenty several Grants all bearing
date on the day and year last mentioned respectively signed with
his hand and under the great seal of the said State Grant unto
the said Thomas Farrar his heirs and assigns all those Twenty
several plantations or Tracts of land situate lying & being on the
North & Middle forks of Saluda River in the County of Greenville
in the said district of Washington, and in the said State of South
Carolina containing each one thousand acres & contiguous to and
adjoining one another duly surveyed for the said Thomas Farrar
by Jesse Carter a Lawful Deputy Surveyor of the said State, and
Certified by Francis Bremer Esquire Surveyor General of the said State
on the fourteenth day of July in the said year of our Lord one thousand
