

ledge have bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver (in due form of law) unto the said John Thomas one negro wench about twenty five years old named Dours to have and to hold the said Negro wench unto the said John Thomas his Ex^{ts} Adms & assigns for ever and I the said Moses Wood for myself my Exors & Adms the said bargained Negro wench unto the said John Thomas his Exors Adms and assigns against all persons shall it well warrant and for ever defend by these presents

Provided Nevertheless that I the said Moses Wood my heirs Exors & Adms or assigns or any of us do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said John Thomas his Ex^{ts} Adms or assigns the sum of fifteen pounds eight shillings lawful Sterling money for redemption of said Negro wench Dours, then this present Bill of sales shall be void & of none effect but if default be made in the payment of the said fifteen pounds eight shillings in part or in the whole contrary to the manner and form aforesaid that then it shall remain in full force
