


This Indenture made the twenty eighth day of March in the
 year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred & ninety five between John Pyle
 of the county of Greenville & state of South Carolina of the one part and
 George Seaborn of the County & state afores^d of the other part W^m McFetche
 that the s^r John Pyle for & in consideration of the sum of Twenty pound ster-
 ling money of the state afores^d to him in hand paid by the s^r George Seaborn at
 & before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
 ledged hath Bargained & sold & by these presents doth Grant Bargain & sell 
 to him the s^r Geo. Seaborn a certain parcel of Land containing Eighty Ac-
 res more or less being part of a tract of Land situate in the County & state
 above mentioned containing eight hundred & sixty acres Granted ^{to} the s^r John
 Pyle by his excellency Thomas Pinckney Esq^r the third day of March
 one thousand Seven hundred & eighty eight the same being Recorded in the
 Secretarys office in Great Book 38 C^o page 191 & examined by Peter Prent-
 ice Secretary aerson line comprehending the quantity first above men-
 tioned, beginning at a B. Oak on Laid out to George Seaborn thence S 25
 W 40 C to a P. Oak thence on a line of S^r Seaborn S 30 E 48 to a
 P. Oak on Maximilian Connors Land thence on John Pyle's land to
 the beginning including a part of the long branch of Baker's Creek the
 waters of Rudy River together with all the appertinances ^{& fixtures} thereto
 belonging to have & to hold the s^r Tract of Land of eighty acres
 more or less therunto belonging to the s^r George Seaborn his heirs
 and assigns forever to the only use of him the s^r George Seaborn his
 heirs & assigns & the s^r John Pyle for himself & his heirs the s^r Tract of
 Land and premises unto the s^r George Seaborn his heirs Executors ad-
 minister & assigns against himself his Executors administration or assign-
 ments and every other person or persons whatsoeuer shall & will warrant &
 ever defend by these presents in W^m McFetche during the s^r John Pyle
 having therunto set his hand & seal the day & year first above written
