The following Bill of Sale from Richard Tankersley to George Tankersley being proven before Ambrose Blackburn Esq. by the oath of John White was presented & Recorded this 6th April 1796

Know all men by these presents that I Richard Tankersley of the State of S. Carolina & Greenville County have bargained sold and delivered unto George Tankersley a Negro woman named Rachel, a Girl named Milly, a Boy named Sam, and another Girl named Clooye, for the consideration of one hundred & thirty pounds Sterling to me in hand paid by the said George Tankersley, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and I the said Richard Tankersley will warrant to him the said George Tankersley his heirs &c. the above named Negroes and their Inceas, free and clear from me my heirs, & from all and every person or persons whatsoever laying any claim title or demand to them the above mentioned Negroes In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 14th day of March 1796
