

The following deed of Conveyance from James Flord to Thomas Terry being proven before John McElroy Esq^r by the oath of Owen Jenkins was presented and recorded this 16th day of April A.D. 1796.

This Indenture made this ninth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three between James Flord of Washington District State of South Carolina of the one part & Thomas Terry of the said State and district of the other part witnesseth that the said James Flord for & in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds lawful money to him in hand well and truly paid by the said Thomas Terry at Hobson the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said James Flord doth hereby acknowledge & thereof & of and from every part & parcel thereof a quiet & discharge the said Thomas Terry his heirs & assigns, and for divers other good causes and considerations hereunto moving have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed & confirmed by these presents as grant bargain sell alien enfeoff & confirm unto the said Thomas Terry his heirs & assigns for ever a certain parcel of land beginning at Peppermill Reeds corner running a straight line to the corner of the said Flord's fence, from thence along the fence to the branch & down the branch to where the said Flord's line crosses the branch on the west side Originally granted unto James Flord signed by his Excellency William Moultrie on the fourth day of December one thousand seven hundred & eighty six as by a plat annexed to the said grant will more fully appear, together with all and singular the houses out houses ways waters paths, bridges, trees fences easements hereditaments appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract of land so described as above belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion, & reversions, remainder & remainders rents issues & profits thereof and every part & parcel thereof, and all the estate right title interest claim & demand whatsoever both in Law & Equity of the said James Flord of in & to the same premises & of in & to every part and parcel thereof to have & to hold the said parcel or tract of land and all and singular other premises above mentioned with the appurtenances unto the said Thomas Terry his heirs & assigns to the only and proper use & behoof of him the said Thomas Terry his heirs and assigns for ever and lastly the said James Flord this his the said tract of land and all and singular the premises above granted with all appurtenances unto the said Thomas Terry this heirs against all persons whatsoever shall & will warrant & for ever defend in & to all whereof the said James Flord doth hereunto set his hand & seal this day & year first above written Sealed and delivered in presence of
