The following Deed of Conveyance from John Parker to Reuben Barrell being
 proven before William Anderson Esq^r by the oath of Mafsey Amasmith was
 presented and Recorded this 18th day of April 1896
 This Indenture made this tenth day of September in the year of our Lord
 one thousand seven hundred and ninety five and in the twentieth year of Ame-
 ricans Independance between John Parker of the State of S^c Carolina & County
 of Greenville of the one part & Reuben Barrell of the State & County aforesaid of the
 other part Witnesseth that whereas in and by a certain Grant bearing date the
 second day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred &
 Eighty six under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esq^r Governor &
 commander in chief in and over the said State having the great seal of the
 State therunto annexed did give and grant unto Sarah Lucas a certain tract or
 parcel of Land containing by estimation one hundred acres lying & being in
 Greenville County & State aforesaid on the wild Cat Creek of South Tyger river
 the place whereon the said John Parker now lives adjoining land surveyed for
 Thomas Davis, and Land surveyed for John Lucas & Land surveyed for Joseph
 Doughty and Land surveyed for Duncan Campbell these lands lay on three
 sides of the same land now conveyed to Barrell by Parker having such
 shapes forms marks buttings & boundings as the plat to the said Grant annex-
 ed doth represent which plat & Grant being duly recorded in the Secretaries
 Office of said State reference therunto had well more fully appear & by the
 said Sarah Lucas conveyed by a deed of Conveyance the above described land
 unto John Parker on the tenth day of November in the year of our Lord
 one thousand seven hundred and ninety four and the said Deed duly
 Recorded in the Clerks Office of said County of Greenville on the thir-
 tyeth day of April one thousand seven hundred and ninety five reference
 therunto had will more fully appear Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the
 said John Parker for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen pounds
 Sterling Money of said State to him in hand well & truly paid by the said
 Reuben Barrell at or before the signing sealing & delivering of these presents
 the recite whereof is hereby fully acknowledged have bargained sold aliened
 conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell releis convey & confirm
 unto the said Reuben Barrell his heirs & Adm^r & assigns all that tract or
 parcel of Land as above described containing one hundred acres beginning on
 a post oak running N 75 W 27 to a post oak, thence N 30 E 51 to a Chesnut, thence
 N 85 E to a stake, thence to the beginning Together with all and singular the Gar-
 dens ways wells waters, water courses woods under woods & menss profits
 commodities hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to have & hold
 the said granted premises of one hundred acres of Land unto the only prop-
 er use and behoof of him the said Reuben Barrell his heirs & assigns

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
