Carolina to him in hand well & truly paid by the s^r. Eschey Forrest the receipt whereof his hereby acknowledged he the s^r. Will^m. Warren hath bargained sold aliened released conveyed & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain sell convey & confirm unto the s^r. Eschey Forrest his heirs & assigns for ever a parcel of land containing one hundred & fifty acres being part of a Tract of Land granted to Tomas Lowry one thousand seven hundred & eighty six situated in the District of Washington on a fork of South Sugar River with all the houses Orchards trees woods under woods commons common of pasture ways waters courses & appurtenances whatsoever to the s^r. belonging or any ways appurtening and all the estate right title Interest dowers claims & demands whatsoever of him the s^r.
