 at stone on the Southward line of said tract running North 20 E 7 chains  
 75 links to white oak marked with eight chops, then North 31 E 12 ch. 65  
 links to red oak with eight chops, then N 70 W 10 chains to red oak & stake  
 at a branch, then down the said branch to Cilders Creek & cross the Creek to the  
 north side of said Creek, then down the said Creek to Enore River, then up  
 the said River with the various courses of said River to where the upper  
 line of the aforesaid tract of land crosses said River, then with the courses  
 of said land to the beginning, all of the aforesaid land within these aforesaid  
 boundaries laid of for two hundred and fifty acres let there be more or less  
 now the aforesaid Gadock Ford for the consideration of the sum of two  
 hundred pounds Sterling Money to him in hand paid by the said Edward  
 Mitcherson the receipt is hereby acknowledged that he the said Gadock Ford  
 is well contented satisfied and paid and hath granted bargained & sold  
 remised, released conveyed unto Edward Mitcherson him his heirs & assigns  
 signe two hundred and fifty acres of land as aforesaid; Together with all  
 and singular the houses gardens Orchards trees woods water courses  
 hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging to the the only  
 proper and absolute use and behoof of him the said Edward Mitcherson  
 his heirs and assigns, and he the said Edward him his heirs Ex<sup>ts</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> or  
 assigns shall and may from time to time & at all times hereafter, have had  
 use occupy possess and enjoy the said plantation or tract of land of two  
 hundred and fifty acres as aforesaid without any manner of Trouble  
 hindrance molestation Interruption or denial of him the said Gadock Ford  
 him his heirs Ex<sup>ts</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> or assigns for ever, In witness whereof the said  
 Gadock Ford have to these presents set my Hand & Seal the day & date first above written
