The State of South Carolina, I know all men by these presents  
that I Solomon Langston Junr. of Laurens County State aforesaid  
planter in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds Sterling  
paid by Solomon Langston Junr. of said County and State have  
granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant  
bargain sell and release unto the said Solomon Langston Junr.  
all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred acres  
more or less, being part of a tract of land containing six hundred  
and thirty nine acres lying in Greenville County State aforesaid  
on the waters of Reedy River formerly owned by John Langston  
deceased & bargained premises is taken off S. Original tract on the  
side of said tract that joins land held by Eaton Hawkins Togeth-  
ther with all and singular the rights members hereditaments &  
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular  
the premises before mentioned unto the said Solomon Langston  
Junr. his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind my-  
self my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant for ever  
defend all and singular the said premises unto the said  
Solomon Langston Junr. his heirs and assigns against myself  
and my heirs, and against every person whomever lawfully  
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness  
my hand and seal this eighth day of November in the year  
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six &  
in the 21<sup>st</sup> year of the Independance of the United States of America
