The following Deed of Conveyance from Larkin Tarant to William T. Hodgson being proven before J^o. M. Cloy Esq^r. by the oath of John White was presented and read this 18th day of January 1797

 Greenville County - } I know all men by these presents that I Larkin Tarant of the County & State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds Sterling money of the said State to me in hand paid by William Tatham Hodgson of the State and County aforesaid have granted bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto William Tatham Hodgson thirty eight and half acres of land lying on the waters of Golden Grove Creek, granted by William Wood 16th July 1784 from William Wood and his wife to John Syle, from John Syle to Larkin Tarant being part of a tract of 300 Acres bounded North by John Southern's land East by George Seaborn's land S. & S. West by Larkin Tarant's land and now about to be conveyed to William Tatham Hodgson Together with all and singular the members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises thereunto belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the said William Tatham Hodgson his heirs & assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto William Tatham Hodgson his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 30th September 1796 & this 21st year of the American Independance
