The following deed of Conveyance from Light Townsen to Thomas Bennett
 being proven before Thomas Camp Esq^r by the oath of Bryan W. Nordin, was
 presented and Recorded this 7th day of April 1797

This Indenture made this second day of February in the year of our Lord
 one thousand seven hundred & ninety seven between Light Townsen of
 the County of Greenville State of South Carolina of the one part, & Thomas
 Bennett of the said County & State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that
 for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds lawful Sterling
 Money of South Carolina to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Bennett
 the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and every part &
 parcel thereof do acquit and discharge the said Thomas Bennett his heirs and
 assigns for ever have given granted sold conveyed and confirmed and by these
 presents do give grant sell release convey and confirm unto the said Thomas Ben-
 nett his heirs and assigns for ever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying
 and being in Greenville County, and on the north side of Horse Creek containing by
 estimation one hundred and sixty eight acres (be the same more or less) and bounded
 as followeth To wit. Beginning at a white oak on the south side of Horse Creek thence
 N 23^o E 10.0 chas - crossing the Creek to a post oak, thence S 50^o E 18 chas. to an oak
 thence S 30 East 39 chas. to an oak on John Camps line thence S 60 W along a line cross-
 ing the Creek 47 chains to said Camps corner red oak thence a conditional line to a
 corner on Hulseys line, thence N 29^o E to the first mentioned beginning Together with
 all Houses orchards gardens meadows pastures feedings pens, woods and under woods
 ways water & water courses Together with all the estate right title interest prop-
 erty claim & demand whatsoever of him the s. Light Townsen in or the
 same or any part or part of the reversion or reversions, remainder & remain-
 ders of all & singular the aforesaid premises and every of their appurten-
 ances to have & to hold the said one hundred & sixty eight acres of land more or
 less & premises and every of their appurtenances unto the s. Thomas Bennett his
 heirs and assigns to their only proper use and behoof free & clear from all Incum-
 brances, whatsoever and farther the said Light Townsen for himself his heirs
 and assigns do covenant and agree to & with the said Thomas Bennett his heirs
 & assigns that him with the right & title of the said land & premises & every of these
 appurtenances against all person or persons whatsoever with warrant & defend
 for ever unto the said Thomas Bennett his heirs & assigns
