


374 This Indenture made this nineteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven between Thomas Camp of the State of S^c Carolina Greenville County of the one part and William Williams of the said State & County of the other part witnesseth that for an in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars paid by the said Will^m Williams the receipt whereof the said Tho^s Camp doth hereby acknowledge the said Tho^s Camp doth hereby acknowledge that the said Tho^s Camp hath bargained and sold aliened & confirmed & by these presents doth bargain & sell alien and confirm unto the said Will^m Williams his heirs and assigns for ever all that tract plantation or tract of land containing ninety acres be the same more or less situate in the County of Greenville on the branches of Horse creek and Reedy River bounded on the S^c parts by the old Indian Boundary on the N^e by Peter Ragsdale line and on N^e by lands belonging John Thomas and on the N^e and E by the said Tho^s Camps land ^{the line laid to for Parkin Camp} being part of a tract of land Originally granted to Tho^s Lewis on the 16 day of July 1784 and recorded in the Secretaries Office in grant Book 25 26 and page 66 reference thereunto may more fully appear Together with all Trees woods under wood liches commons of pasture advantages heridiments ways waters water courses and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and also the reversion and reversions remainder Premainders rents and services of the same and of every parts thereof and all the Interest claim and demand whatsoever of him the S^c Tho^s Camp either in law or equity unto the same to have and to hold the S^c Tract of ninety acres of land more or less and all singular the premises above mentioned with ways partes and parcels thereof with the appurtenances unto the S^c Will^m Williams his heirs and assigns for ever, and the S^c Tho^s Camp for himself and his heirs the said Tract of ninety acres of land more or less with every the premises thereunto belonging against him the S^c Tho^s Camp his heirs and assigns and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, unto Will^m Williams his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Thomas Camp hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written.
