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The following Deed of Conveyance from Battle Birdsong to Nicholas Davis  
 being proven before Wm. Mitcheson Esq. by the oath of Ephraim Purr  
 was presented and recorded this 21<sup>st</sup> day of April 1799

This Indenture made this twentieth day of March one thousand seven  
 hundred and ninety five and of the Independency of America the  
 nineteenth between Battle Birdsong of the one part and Nicholas Davis  
 of the other part witnesseth that for and in the consideration of ten  
 pounds Sterling to the said Birdsong in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby  
 acknowledged hath bargained granted and sold and by these presents bar-  
 gain grant and sell unto the said Nicholas Davis his heirs or  
 assigns a certain parcel of land lying on the north side of  
 Childers Creek being part of a Tract of land granted said  
 Battle Birdsong in the year one thousand seven hun-  
 dred and ninety one con-  
 taining 1262 acres the parcel of land  
 hereby granted is as above represented beginning at a stake and running N 20 E  
 26. 50 to a red oak then as is above plotted supposed to contain twenty acres and  
 all houses way waters claims profits Interest tithes hereditaments appur-  
 tenances whatsoever to the said premises belonging and hereby granted  
 to the said Nicholas Davis his heirs or assigns for ever and the said Battle  
 Birdsong do by these presents Land grant to S. Davis his heirs
