Know all men by these presents that I Samuel James Atton of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of one hundred dollars to me paid by Isaac Wickliff of the County of State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release, unto the said Isaac Wickliff part of two lots in the town of Pleasantburg (Viz) N. 11 & N. 12, Beginning at a Stake running thence N. 74 1/2 W 252 1/2 feet to a Stake 3<sup>d</sup>, thence N. 15 1/2 E. 100 feet to a Stake 3<sup>d</sup>, thence S. 74 1/2 E 252 1/2 feet to a Stake 3<sup>d</sup>, thence S. 15 1/2 W 100 feet to the beginning containing by estimation one acre and Twenty square Rods be the same more or less agreeable to the Chart of said Village reference thereunto had may more fully and at large appear Together with all and Singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to have and to hold all and Singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Isaac Wickliff his heirs & assigns for ever
