

414 I know all men by these presents that I Joseph Vawn of Ninety six District & State of South Carolina am held and firmly bound unto Joseph Terry of State & District aforesaid in the sum of five hundred pounds to be paid unto the said Joseph Terry his heirs Executors or assigns for the True & faithful payment of which I bind me my heirs Executors & assigns firmly by these presents sealed with my seal & dated this fourteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty five

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Joseph Vawn his heirs or assigns doth make or cause to be made unto the said Joseph Terry his heirs or assigns lawful right & title to the one half of the plantation on which they both now live (the lower end) as soon as he can get lawful right himself that then the above obligation to be void and of no effect otherwise to remain in full force & virtue given under my hand & seal this fourteenth of July the day & year above written

414 The following power of Atty from Alexander Pitt Buchanan to Thomas Beale being acknowledged before David Hunter & James Anderson Esq. Gen. Justices of the State of Virginia & County of Berkeley was presented and Recorded this 2nd Sept. 1794

I know all men by these presents that I Alexander Pitt Buchanan of the County of Berkeley in the State of Virginia have for divers good considerations nominated constituted and appointed and by these presents do nominate constitute and appoint & in my stead and place depute Mr. Thomas Beale of Fincastle in Bolivar County of the said State my True and lawful Attorney for me and in my name to enter into one thousand acres of land, situate in the district of ninety six in the State of South Carolina admeasured and laid out unto Jacob Bannon Site in two different plantations or Tracts of land of five hundred acres each having such form and marks bullings and boundings as the different plots annexed to the different grants of the said State of South Carolina in pursuance and by virtue of an Ordinance of the said State shew and exhibit; and also to enter into two thousand acres of land in the said District of South Carolina admeasured and laid out unto George Site in four different plantations in manner aforesaid and by virtue of the Ordinance aforesaid; and the said lands or any part thereof for me and in my name to bargain & sell by Indenture or otherwise for me & in my name to give so as to
