

Arnold to Lewis Williams in the year of our Lord 1793 beginning on the said Creek at a maple Ana Rowensline running thence S<sup>o</sup> 78 E 58 chains to a stake corner thence running S<sup>o</sup> 9<sup>o</sup> W 37-50 to a stake corner, Joseph Ruds line thence running N 56<sup>o</sup> W 65 to a white oak corner on the s<sup>o</sup> creek, thence up the creek with its meanders to the beginning corner containing by estimation one hundred and fifty acres (be the same more or be it less) adjoining Richard Brown (deceased) Joseph Reed & Isaac James Together with all and singular the Houses, ways waters passages, fences easements hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the said plantation or Tract of one hundred & fifty acres of land (more or less) or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders rents Issues & profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said parcel or Tract of one hundred and fifty acres of land (more or less) and all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Hum Cobb his heirs and assigns to the only proper use benefit and behoof of him the said Humphrey Cobb his heirs and assigns for ever and lastly the said Lewis Williams for himself and his heirs the said Tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said Hum Cobb his heirs and assigns against all persons whatsoever claiming by from or under him or any of them shall and will warrant & for ever defend the same in witness whereof the said Lewis Williams hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above written

The following deed of Conveyance from James Bell to Samuel Bell being proven before John Tubb Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of James Fisher was presented and Recorded this 11<sup>th</sup> day of Sept<sup>r</sup> 1797  
 State South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I James Bell of Greenville County in the State afores<sup>d</sup> in the consideration of two hundred dollars to me paid by Samuel Bell of Spartanburg County in the State afores<sup>d</sup> have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Samuel Bell I here described beginning at v<sup>o</sup> Reedy River on the South side of the same running thence S 22 W to a red oak corner, thence 688 63 ch & 50 links to a stake thence N 22 E to the River thence up meanders of said River
