



The following deed of Conveyance from George Harrison & Elisabeth his wife to Thomas Edwards being proven before David Goodlett Esq: by the oath of James Jewell was presented & Recorded this 15th Sept. 1797

The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that we George Harrison & Elisabeth Harrison his wife of Pendleton County and State aforesaid for and in consideration of one hundred pounds to us paid by Thomas Edwards of Greenville County in State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas Edwards all that tract of land whereon the said Harrison formerly lived containing four hundred and seventy nine acres more or less which land was granted to James Sett by his Excellency William Moultrie Esq: and the said Sett did convey the above mentioned land unto George Harrison as will appear by a deed Recorded in the Office of Greenville the seventh day of January 1795 Recorded in Book C page 546. 547 & 548. the said land beginning at a post oak corner on the Side of the Road leading to Paris Ford & running thence S 47 E 22 ch. to a Black oak on Benson's land, thence N 44 E 31 ch. 50 links to a post oak on Blasingame's land, thence S 51 E 28 ch. 50 links to a pine on Blasingame's land, thence N 31 E 54 ch. to a stake on Perry's land, thence N 44 W 95 ch. to a chestnut on the side of a Road, thence to the beginning containing four hundred and seventy nine acres more or less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Edwards his heirs and assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant & for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Edwards his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this seventh day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven and in the 21st year of the Independency of the United States of America.
