The following deed of Conveyance from Jesse Chandler to William Eubanks being proven before Jesse Chandler by the oath of Philip Perry was presented and recorded this 15th September 1797 State of South Carolina, - Know all men by these presents that I Jesse Chandler of Greenville County in the State aforesaid am held and firmly bound unto William Eubanks of S^t. State & County aforesaid in the consideration sum of thirty pounds Sterling money to me paid by the said William Eubanks, and the said Jesse Chandler have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Eubanks all that Tract of land containing one hundred & fifty acres more or less situate lying and being on the State House branch of Needy river on the South side of Brush Creek in Greenville County State aforesaid bounded N.W. by Perry's land to red oak from thence E. by vacant land to red oak from thence S.W. to red oak, from thence E. to a red oak Station on Turpin's line, from thence to Scogins line, and from thence to Hugh Roark's line and along said line to the red oak corner from thence to the beginning Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Eubanks his heirs and assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the S^r.
