

post oak, thence South to a stake along Wadsworths line thence
West to the conditional line on a black oak thence North to a certain
white oak in the Branch below the fork on the conditional line, thence
to the beginning corner Including one hundred acres be it more or
less Together with every Right Title privilege and emolument to the
said land belonging or in any wise appertaining and said
James Fisher doth hereby bind himself his heirs Executors Administ:
and assigns well and Truly warrant and defend for ever the
aforesaid premises with all the appurtenances to him the said
James Fisher his heirs or assigns for ever or claims in Testimony

The following deed of Conveyance from Hugh Crumblers to Wm
Ball being proven before Angus Campbell Esq. of Laurens County by
the oath of Peter Smith was Recorded this 15th January 1798
This Indenture made this first day of May in the year of our
Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four and in the
eighteenth year of American Independance between Hugh Crum-
blers planter of Laurens County and State of South Carolina of the
one part and William Ball Senior of the County & State afores^d
of the other part witnesseth that the said Hugh Crumblers for & in
consideration of the sum of ten shillings to him in hand paid
by the aforesaid William Ball have granted bargained & sold &
by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell & convey unto the
said W^m Ball Senior his heirs & assigns for ever the half of one certain
Tract of land situate lying and being on the waters of mountain creek
be the same more or less contained in a plat granted to Hugh Crumblers
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two
Beginning on a post oak on Charles Eslea land & so round on Christopher
