The following deed of Conveyance from William Russell to John Morgan being proven before Robert M. Case Esq. by the oath of Isaac Elledge was presented and Recorded 15th January 1798.
This Indenture made this Twenty ninth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four between William Russell of Greenville County and State of South Carolina and John Morgan both of the same place witnesseth that the said William Russell for and in consideration of the sum of 100 pounds to him in hand paid by said John Morgan the receipt whereof he the said William Russell doth hereby acknowledge and himself fully satisfied and paid hath granted bargained sold and conveyed & confirmed and by these presents doth fully freely clearly and absolutely grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said John Morgan his heirs and assigns for ever a tract of land containing one hundred acres more or less in the bounds as follows lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid on a creek called Montin Creek the waters of the Enoree beginning at a Starpon tree in W. Russell's line and running down the said Creek with Silousides to a black oak and then a Conventional line made between Russell and the S. Morgan to a white oak on a branch called Taylor's branch & then to the beginning including the plantation whereon William Morgan now lives on together with every right Title privilege and Emolument to the said land belonging ordinary writs appertaining and the said William Russell doth hereby bind himself his heirs Executors Administrators well and truly to warrant and for ever defend the aforesaid premises with all the appurtenances to him the said John Morgan his heirs or assigns for ever defend the aforesaid premises free and clear from all Incumbrances and claims what ever in Testimony whereof the said William Russell hath set his hand set the day and date above written.

The following deed of Conveyance from James Blackstock to William Percy being proven before Amb. Blackburn Esq. by the oath of Elsher Stevens was presented and Recorded this 16th January 1798.
