

This Indenture made in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven between Richard Brasel in the County of Greenville and in the State of South Carolina of the one part and Samuel Bowen of the other part in the same County and State aforesaid witnesseth that they the said Richard Brasell for and in consideration of the sum of thirty four pounds ster-ling money to him in hand paid by the said Samuel Bowen the receipt whereof I acknowledge he the said Brasel hath granted sold alienated released con-veyed and confirmed and doth by these presents both bargain sell al-ways release convey and conform unto the said Samuel Bowen his heirs and assigns for ever in his actual possession being now a certain tract of land containing one hundred and twenty one acres situated being and lying on the south side of clear Creek of Tygar River beginning on the south side of s<sup>d</sup> Clear creek running all along the old line from the Creek to a red oak Saplin for a corner thence fifty six west to the corner, thence along the said line to the Creek and down the s<sup>d</sup> Creek to the begining it being measured is one hundred and twenty one acres it being a tract of land granted to s<sup>d</sup> Richard Brasel on the seventh day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven s<sup>d</sup> Grant with the plat being duly recorded in the Secretaries Office of s<sup>d</sup> State office being there-unto well more fully appear bound on William Moray and Daniel Bellays land together & singler the houses and out houses woods & under woods ways water paths ways & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining and also the recreations and every part thereof with every appertaining thereto and every right title & claim & demands whatsoever of him the said Richard Brasell of in one hundred and twenty one acres of land above s<sup>d</sup> mentioned to have and to hold the said tract of & all and singler the premises aforesaid & every part thereof with every appertaining unto the said Samuel Bowen his heirs & assigns to the proper use and behoof of him the said Samuel Bowen his heirs & assigns for ever, and the said Richard Brasel for himself & his heirs the said one hundred and twenty one acres & its premises and every part thereof against him his heirs & assigns of all and every other person or persons whatsoever to the said Samuel Bowen to his heirs and assigns shall and will for ever warrant and for ever defend by these presents in witness whereunto s<sup>d</sup> Rich Brasel hath set his hand & seal the first day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven.
