The following deed of conveyance from John Ware to Jonathan Pinnell being proven before me Amberg Blackburn Esq^r by the oath of Charles Garrison was presented and recorded this 20th of March 1798 The State of South Carolina know all men by these presents that John Ware of the County of Greenville and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling to me in hand paid by Jonathan Pinnell of the State and County aforesaid have granted Bargained sold and Released unto the said Jonathan Pinnell all that plantation or tract of Land lying in Greenville County and State aforesaid containing Two Hundred acres be the same more or less Beginning on a pine corner running N 1/2 to a Maple corner on the branch thence Down the branch to the little grove up the little grove to a water run across thence Running N 1/2 to a branch thence down the said branch to a small Corn field from thence to a poplar on little grove at the Head of the Shoal and from thence Condition at Line to the Beginning being part of a tract of land originally granted unto Nathaniel Wood by the Excellency Ben Gaimin Guard Esq^r on the sixteenth day of July 1784 together with all and singular the premises heretofore to and appertaining to the said premises belonging to any wide in demerit or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jonathan Pinnell his heirs and assigns forever and I do here by my self my heirs Executors and adm^r to warrant and defend for ever all and singular the said premises unto the said Jonathan Pinnell his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other Person or whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any other part thereof witness my hand and seal the 16th day of September in the year of our Lord 1797 and in the 21st year of the Independence of the United States of America witness Charles Garrison, Notary Public, John Ware
