State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I John
 Hughes of the county of greenhill in the state aforesaid in consideration of
 the sum of forty pounds Sterling to me paid by Thomas Deen of the
 County and State aforesaid have granted bargain sold and released and
 by the Presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said
 Thomas Deen all that plantation or tract of Land situated in greenhill
 County on the middle fork of the Broad fork of the Broad River
 being a branch called zacharys fork of Broad River and the
 East Boundary by Land laid out for James James Harrison East by
 Michael Robbins Land & west by West by ^{Wm} Bonds &
 John Hughes Lands containing one hundred and fifty acres Together
 with all and singular the rights member hereditaments and
 appertinances to the said premises belonging in any wise Incident
 or appertaining to have & to hold all aforesaid the premises before
 mentioned unto the said Thomas Deen his heirs & assigns forever
 and I do here by bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators
 to warrant and forever defend all & singular the said premises unto
 the said Thomas Deen his heirs & against all persons whatsoever
 meaning to convey such a title as I have obtained from the State
 of South Carolina as Witness to the same I have hereunto my hand
 and seal this Third Day of March 1796 and in the 20th year of America
 an Independence
