


Robert Cooke Esq. by the oath of Thomas Prince Esq. was presented and recorded this 11<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1798  
 State of South Carolina. I know all men by these presents that I Adam  
 to wit ~~Waller~~ of the Sheriff County and State of N. Carolina  
 Consideration of the sum of Twenty five pounds Sterling to me paid by  
 Eneas Earle of Granville County & State of S. Carolina have granted bargain  
 & Release and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and Release unto  
 the said Eneas Earle a tract of one hundred and eighty six acres of land situate  
 in the aforesaid county of Granville <sup>on</sup> branches of S. Tygar river and bounded  
 by lines running S. E. by James Grouse land S. E. by James Maxwell  
 & unknown <sup>S. E.</sup> by Jeremiah Patton S. E. by Baylis Cole; which  
 said tract of one hundred and eighty six acres of land was granted to me by  
 his Excellency Andrew Underhorst late governor of S. Carolina by  
 patent bearing date the fourth day of June in the year of our Lord one  
 thousand seven hundred and ninety six as by the said grant and  
 plat thereunto annexed will more fully and at large appear  
 reference being thereunto had which I like wise transfer unto the said  
 Earle for the said purpose together with all and singular the rights  
 members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises  
 belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and  
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Eneas Earle his  
 heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and  
 administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said  
 premises unto the said Eneas Earle his heirs and assigns against my  
 self my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully  
 to claim the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have hereunto  
 set my hand and affixed my seal the 4 day of January in the year  
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight and of American  
 Independence the twenty second signed seal and Delivered in  
 the presents of us
