

22 The Following Deed of Conveyance from John Cambell to  
William Ferguson being proven before David Goodlett Esq<sup>r</sup>  
by the Oath of James Ferguson was presented and Recorded  
this 7<sup>th</sup> day of October 1800

This indenture made the sixth day of January in the  
year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred and ninety  
Eight Between John Cambell of the County of Greenville  
and State of South Carolina of the one Part and William  
Ferguson of the aforesaid State and County of the other  
Part Witnesseth that the said John Cambell for and in  
consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars to him in  
hand paid by the said William Ferguson at and before  
the sealing and Delivery of these presents (the receipt  
of and payment whereof is here by acknowledged) he  
the said John Cambell hath bargained and sold and by  
these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said  
William Ferguson a Plantation or tract of Land  
Containing Twenty acres lying and being in Green-  
ville County on the waters of Bush Creek Begin-  
ning on a Post Oak and running S 23 W 1/8 to a  
Post Oak thence N 14 W a certain distance to  
make up the quantity of Twenty acres thence a straight line to the  
beginning which said Tract of Land containing twenty acres  
with all and singular of its appurtenances the said John Cambell  
doth from him self and his heirs and from all and Every person  
and persons will warrant and for ever defend to the said W<sup>m</sup> Ferguson  
his heirs and assigns for ever in witness whereof the said John  
Cambell hath here unto set his hand and affixed his seal the day  
and date year above written
