 tenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
 appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the  
 premises before mentioned unto the said John Peck  
 his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self  
 my heirs Executors administrators to warrant and forever  
 defend all and singular the premises unto the said  
 John Peck his heirs and assigns against myself and  
 my heirs and against every person whomsoever  
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
