a post oak running $s^o 54^o E$ to a stake on Connors
old line thence S to a post oak from thence E to a
stake on Paul Amers line from thence the condi-
tional corner made between John Campbells and
Paul Amers from thence running down the branch
to William Ferguson from thence running $S^o 56^o$
 W to a post oak from thence $s^o 20^o E$ to a post
oak from thence $s^o 70^o W$ to a post oak from thence
to the beginning corner which said Tract of land
containing two hundred acres more or less with all
and every its appertinances the said John Campbell
doth from himself, and his heirs and from all and
every other other person and persons will warrant
and for ever defend to the said John Campbell his heirs
and assigns for ever in witness whereof the said John
Campbell have hereunto set his hand and affixed
his seal the day and year above written
