then by lawfull Heirship to said John Steel & from said  
John Steel to said Nicholas White now these Adventurers  
Witnesseth that he the said John Steel hath  
for and in consideration of the some of fifty pounds  
Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Nicholas  
White the receipt is here by acknowledged hath bargained  
sold made over conveyed and confirmed and by these presents  
doth bargain sell alien make over convey and confirm  
unto the said Nicholas White part of said four hundred  
acres of land and is bound as follows Beginning at a  
conditional stake of Running supposed to a black  
Oak of thence supposed N<sup>o</sup> E to a ash on the bank of  
the little creek the waters of Durbins creek thence  
up said creek the various courses of said creek to  
a conditional maple of on the bank of said creek  
thence supposed N<sup>o</sup> to a pine of thence supposed  
E to a stake of thence east to the Beginning  
supposed to include 200 acres be the same more or less  
together with all and singular the appurtenances there unto  
belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the only  
proper use and behoof of him the said Nicholas White  
his Heirs and assigns and he the said Nicholas White his
