

219 The following Act of conveyance from Nicholas White
to William Goldsmith being proven before James Kelgore
Esquire by the oath of Solomon White was presented
and recorded this 20th day of June 1807

The Indenture made this 18th day of November in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and the twenty
fifth year of American Independence between
Nicholas White of the County of Elbert and
State of Georgia of the one part & William Goldsmith
of Granville District and State of South Carolina
of the other part Witnesseth in and by a certain
grant bearing date the fifth day of June 1786 recorded
in grant book A be book page 93 sign^d by his Excellency
William Moultrie Esquire then Governor and commander
in chief in and over the State aforesaid and grants unto
Robert Goodwin a Plantation or tract of one hundred
and fifty two acres of land on both sides of Durbins
Creek then by lawful titles to Daniel Wrights then
from said Daniel Wright by lawful titles to John
Wilson then by lawful titles to Nicholas White
now this Indenture Witnesseth that he the said Nicholas
White hath for and in consideration of the sum of three
hundred Dollars to him in hand paid by the said William
Goldsmith the receipt where of is here by acknowledged that
bargained sold made over and conveyed & confirmed and by
these presents doth bargain sell alien make over convey
& confirm unto the said William Goldsmith all that
part of the above tract of land lying and being on the
south side of Durbins Creek situate lying and being in
the County of Greenville beginning at a stake B.
