

The following deed of conveyance from David Franum to John
Camp being proven before Joseph Dunklin Esq^r by the oath of
of James Dunklin was presented and recorded at the 14th July 1807
The State of South Carolina — know all men by these
presents that I David Franum of Greenville County in the
State aforesaid in consideration of twenty dollars to some in
hand paid by John Camp of the State and County aforesaid have
granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the said John Camp a tract of
land containing one acre situate in the County aforesaid
lying and being to include the said John Camps buildings
beginning on a light wood stake corner B^r running thence
a south west course four rod to a stake corner B^r thence
S^o course forty rod to a stake B^r thence a square corner to
the old Original line of Benjamin Arnold and along
line to the beginning stake corner it being part of a
tract of two hundred acres of land Originally granted
to Ben^g Arnold on the second day of Feb^r 1789

Together with all and singular the rights members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said John Camp his heirs and assigns forever and
I do hereby bind my self, my heirs Executors and administra-
tors to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said John Camp his heirs and assigns
