The State of Carolina, — know all men by these presents that I David Franum of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of five hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Elijah Bennett of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Elijah Bennett all that plantation or tract of land containing 300 acres (be the same more or less) situate in the District aforesaid lying on the branches of house Creek of Red River beginning on a stake 3^d on John Arnolds line running thence 60th 67th ch^s to a red oak 3^d on the said John Arnolds line thence N 10th W 35th ch^s on John Chapmans line to a stake 3^d thence S 85th E 5th ch^s 50 links on Moses Lingo to a pine 3^d thence S 56th 23th ch^s on said Lingo line to a stake 3^d thence S 87th E 10th ch^s to a post oak on Joseph Lawes line thence S 60th E 16th 50 on said Lawes line to a post oak 3^d thence S 64th E 8th to a post stake 3^d on said Lawes line thence S 23th W 25th ch^s on the said Lawes line to a Hickory 3^d thence S 70th E 18th 50 to a red oak 3^d on Thomas
