This Indenture made the 18<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>r</sup> in the  
of our lord 1801 between Edwin Lunsford of Carolina  
Greenville District of the one part and Wm Walton  
Jen<sup>r</sup> of the state of S Carolina and the County of  
Rutherford of the other part Witnesseth that the  
said Edwin Lunsford for and in consideration of the  
sum of Thirty pounds Current money of Carolina  
to him the said Edwin Lunsford in hand well and truly  
paid by the said William Walton the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged by the said Edwin Lunsford hath  
hath granted bargain<sup>d</sup> sold a line released conveyed and  
confermed and by these presents doth grant bargain  
sell alien release & conferment unto the said Wm  
Walton his heirs and assigns forever a tract or parcel of  
land containing ten acres in a square form fifty four poles  
in length and thirty in breadth from a white oak corner tree  
of his 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> Maddy's line which is to be the long side of the  
said ten acres of land situate on a branch of A Saluda in the  
south corner of a tract of land containing four thousand  
acres granted to Robert Parris dated the seventh day of March  
1788 with all the Houses Orchards trees woods under  
wood Commons of pastures ways waters water courses and
