 bind ourselves our heirs executors & administrators to warrant  
 and for ever defend all and singular the said Premises unto  
 the said John Chandler his heirs and assigns against ourselves  
 and our heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully  
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - We sign our  
 hands and seals this twelfth day of March in the year of our  
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and one, and in the twenty fifth year  
 of the Independence of the United States of America.
