State of South Carolina. Know all men by these Presents  
 that I James Holland of Greenville District and State aforesaid in  
 consideration of One thousand dollars to me in hand paid by Thom.  
 Holland of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargained  
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the  
 said Thomas Holland a Plantation or Tract of Land containing  
 ninety eight acres (be the same more or less) Situate in the District  
 aforesaid, lying on Line Creek waters of Saluda River beginning  
 on an ash 3x running thence N. 25 E 8 Ch. to a Stake 3x thence N  
 50 E 30. 50. to a dead tree 3x thence S 41 E. 25 Ch. to a Stake 3x  
 thence S 50 W. 43 Ch. to a Hickory on Line Creek thence up the  
 Meanders of said Creek to the beginning together with all &  
 singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances  
 to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertain-  
 -ing to have and to hold all and singular the premises before men-  
 -tioned unto the said Thomas Holland to him & his heirs & assigns  
 for ever, I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & administra-  
 -tors to warrant and for ever defende all and singular the said  
 premises unto y. s<sup>c</sup> Tho. Holland to him & his heirs & assigns against  
 myself and my heirs & against every other person whomsoever  
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof -
