City of Charleston in the State aforesaid in consideration
of the sum of Eighty Dollars to me paid by David
Gilleland of Greenville District in the State aforesaid
have granted bargained sold and released and by these
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
said David Gilleland all that ^{part of} one hundred and forty
six Acres more or less laying in Greenville District
on oil Corn Creek waters of the middle bar of Saluda
River originally ~~surveyed~~ ^{surveyed} for Thomas Wood & after wards granted
to Job Calcock as by reference to the Grant will more fully
appear Beginning on a Pine thence N^o 25 W. 9 out to white
oak thence N^o 65 East 8 out to a W. oak thence S. 25 East
2 out to a Hickory thence S. 3 West 8 out to a Hickory
thence S. 65 W. 4 out & one chain to the beginning pine
Corner Together with all and singular the rights members
Holdsittments and appertanances to the said premises
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to
have and to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said David Gilleland His and
assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my
Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for
ever defend all and singular the said premises unto
the said David Gilleland His and assigns against
myself and my heirs and against every person whom
soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same on any
part here of Witness my hand and seal this twelfth
day of January in the year of our Lord one Thousand
Eight hundred and two and in the twenty sixth year
of the independence of the United States of America
