

The State of South Carolina: Know all Men by these presents that I John Chapman of Greenville District, once State of said in Consideration of the sum of two thousand Dollars to me in hand paid by John H. Harrison of the said State & District, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John H. Harrison a Tract of Land containing one hundred and three acres to the more or less situate in the District aforesaid on Reddy River beginning on a Beach 3+ on said River, running thence E. 25. 10 on James Kelleys line to a Oak 3+ thence North 17-20 on Chandler line to a Red Oak 3+ thence West 60, to a Beach on Reddy River thence down said River with its meanders to the beginning, being part of a Tract of 640 acres Originally granted to John Winn on the 18th day of July 1784. Recorded in Grant Book A A A A page 57.) Together with all & singular the Rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John H. Harrison his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs &c. as Adm^{or} to warrant & for ever defend the said premises unto the said John H. Harrison his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs & assigns & against every other person whomsoever claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand and Seal this twenty seventh day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and one - Signed Sealed & delivered in the presence of, William Miller
