Located in Grant book C C C C page 500. Situated in the District aforesaid on the Cedar Shoal branch the waters of Reedy River, then conveyed to said Bishop, now from said Bishop to s^r Brooks, part of the tract, beginning at the South bank of the Cedar Shoal branch running S 75 10 E a Red Oak the Original Corner, thence N 35 W 20^{ch} to a Red Oak old corner, thence the old line S 75 W 14^{ch} to a Red Oak the old corner, thence N 35 W 48^{ch} on the old line to a Stake, the Original Corner, thence N 35 E 50^{ch} on the old line to a Red Oak the Old Corner, thence on the old line S 50 E at 27^{ch} to a Red Oak corner made for Alex. Smith, then S 3 E to the South bank of the Cedar Shoal branch, thence down the Meanders of the branch to the beginning supposed to contain two hundred & fifteen acres more or less.
