Hone from W. Hone to John Ashmore & from John Ashmore to the s^d. Benjamin Jones. as by reference therunto will fully appear known and called Carrs Bottom - together with all & singular the rights members here detarnents & appertinances to the s^d. premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining: to have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the s^d. James Harrison his heirs and assigns for ever. ~~and I do hereby bind~~ against myself and my heirs or any other person legally claiming under me the same or any part thereof.
