Beginning on a black Oak and running S 25 E. 16. 50 to a post Oak, thence East 25. 10 to a Oak, thence S 10 N. 36. 70 to a pine, thence S 25 N. 12. 50 to a post Oak, thence N. 24 W. 22. 50 to a post Oak, thence S 70 W. 57. to a pine thence N. 5 E. 25. 60 to Woods line, thence down the creek running on Woods line to the course, then running with the Woods line to a post Oak Course, thence South 61. E. 25. 80 to the beginning which said tract of land containing two hundred & two acres more or less, together with all and singular the rights and appurtenances & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned & sold unto the said James M. Cope his heirs and assigns for ever. in fee Simple and I do for and defend all and singular the aforesaid premises unto the S. James M.
