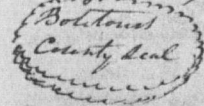

I know all men by these Presents, that I Taverner Beales of the County
of Botetourt and State of Virginia do hereby make Constable appoint
my Son Thomas Beales of the County and State aforesaid my true &
lawful Attorney, for me and in my name and use to ask for demand
and receive all sums of money that may be due to me within the
State of South Carolina, and in failure of payment to sue for and
recover the same, and to give proper discharges for the same, and
also to sell and dispose of my Lands lying in the said State of
South Carolina and to receive the Consideration money for such
sales, and I do hereby Authorise and empower my said Attorney
to ^{and sufficient lites in fee Simple for the whole}
or any part of my Lands lying in the State of South Carolina to any
purchaser or purchasers, and pay & settle any demands
that is or may be against me in the State of South Carolina in conse-
quence of transacting this power and in every respect to act in the
Premises as fully to all intents and purposes as I could were I
personally present, hereby ratifying and confirming whatsoever
my said Attorney may lawfully do in the Premises - In
Witness where of I have hereunto set my hand and seals this
tenth day of June, One thousand Seven hundred & thirty Six

Botetourt County Virginia (to wit) I do certify that Taverner
Beales personally appeared before me William Wilson a Justice
of the Peace for the said County & acknowledged the above power
of Attorney to his son Thomas Beales to be his act and deed. Given under
my hand this Eleventh day of June one thousand seven hundred & thirty
Six, and in the Commonwealth the twentieth Year - William Wilson.
