Oak Corner on the bank of said Creek, thence up the meanders

corner, thence N. 50 E. eight chains to the begining corner  
including the head of a small branch of said Creek which  
includes the above mentioned two lots of land to be leased  
Together with all and singular the rights members  
incastments and appurtenances & privileges unto the  
only proper use and behoof of them the said William  
Wigginton and Fildon Wigginton during their natural  
Lives, or Pleasures, or either of theirs to occupy posses &  
enjoy the above mentioned two lots, Provided they or either  
of them shall on the first day of March next or before the  
Tenth and pay as rent to the above mentioned sum of five  
Dollars, and on or before the first day of March in every  
succeeding year the like sum of Five dollars and Pro  
vided the said Wiggantons or either of them shall  
enter into actual Cultivation on the six & three  
quarter Acres lot, they are to Render and pay on or  
before the first day of March thereafter in addition  
to the aforesaid Five dollars the like sum of three
