


bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joel Shelton all that tract of Land the said Shelton lives on beginning at a pine on Edwards line thence along said line to Snowy line cornering on a stake, continuing on said line to post oak corner, continuing on said line to Sheltons line cornering on a post oak it being a part of a Tract of Land granted to the said decedent by his Excellency Charles Pinckney Esq. Governor for the time being did give & grant the said decedent 618. acres the 6 of February 1792 this being a part of said tract supposed to be 1000 acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joel Shelton his heirs and assigns for ever. and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors adm^{rs} to warrant & for ever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Joel Shelton his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. as witness my hand & seal this twenty sixth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
