

This Indenture made this twenty second day of July one thousand seven hundred and **93** between John Pyle of South Carolina & Greenville County of the One part, and Edward Landers of the said State and County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John Pyle doth for and in consideration of the sum of Ten pounds lawful Sterling Money to him in hand well and truly paid above before the selling & delivery of these Presents by the said Edward Landers the Receipt thereof is hereby fully acknowledged has given granted bargained sold aliened released & confirmed and by these Presents doth give grant bargain sell alien release & confirm unto him the said Edward Landers his heirs and assigns forever, all that part of a certain tract of Land lying on Bakers Creek of Puddy River in Greenville County Originally granted to the said John Pyle for eight hundred and sixty acres and signed by Governor Pinckney on the third day of March 1788. All that part of said tract of land beginning on the Original line and on a Pine Station thence N. E. 28° with the said line to a Post Oak Corner thence N. W. 45° twelve Chains to a Post Oak. thence S. W. 30° thirty seven Chains to a Black Oak Corner from thence to the beginning Containing sixty five Acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the trees ways her easements & appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining with the Reversion & Reservations, Remainder and Remainders Rents Issues & Profits thereof. To have and to hold the said Parcel or Tract of Land as above described with their and every of their Appurtenances unto the said
