consideration of the sum of twenty dollars to me paid by  
John Butler of the Dist. afores<sup>d</sup>. Have granted bargained  
sold & Released and by these Presents do grant bargain  
sell and release unto the said John Butler a certain piece  
or parcel of land laying and being in the Dist. afores<sup>d</sup>.  
on the North side of the middle fork of Tyger River  
beginning at a Stake on the bank of the River & running  
thence N. 29 E. 8 Chains to a Scurwood thence N. 28 88<sup>th</sup>  
40 Ch. to a Red Oak thence S 82 W. 1 Ch. to a post Stake  
thence S. W. 27 1/2 Ch. to a Stake on the bank of the River  
thence down the several Meanders of the River to the beginning  
Containing by estimation fifty seven Acres be the same  
more or less being the lower end on the North side of  
the lower of a Tract granted by Patent bearing date  
the 21<sup>st</sup> day of January 1785. unto Allen Gowen & by  
him Conveyed to me (with this exception that I have  
free privilege to occupy the lands I have now under  
fence during my life) Together with all and singular  
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said Premises belonging or in any wise appur-  
taining. To have and to hold all and singular the  
above mentioned premises unto the said John Butler  
& his heirs & assigns forever myself my heirs Executors &
