therein mentioned, and that he saw Thomas  
Jenkins Jr. with himself sign their names as  
witnesses to the same, sworn to and subscribed

The State of South Carolina Know all men by these  
Present that I Thomas Jenkins of the State aforesaid  
and District of Greenville for the sum of two hundred  
dollars paid by Owen Jenkins the receipt whereof I hereby  
fully acknowledge have granted, bargained sold &  
delivered, and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
and deliver to the said Owen Jenkins of the District  
& State aforesaid. All that part of a tract of Land  
originally granted to me the said Thomas Jenkins by  
his Excellency Benjamin Guirard on the fiftenth day  
of October 1784. of a Six hundred and forty acres lying  
on the South side of Ouedy River in the State and  
District aforesaid, being the whole of said tract
