To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned to the said J. Alexander him his heirs & assigns forever, together with the right members incidents and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining and I do hereby bind myself my heirs &c. to warrant and forever defend the S. premises to him the said J. Alexander him his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs only from legally claiming the same or any part thereof. as Witness thereto I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourth day of July One thousand eight hundred and two
