I know all men by these Presents that I John Westmoreland of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of Three hundred dollars to me in hands paid by John Moon of the District and State aforesaid I the said John Westmoreland have granted bargained sold and released and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Moon, ~~All~~ that tract or Plantation of land aforesaid to contain seventy acres, more or less. Situate in Greenville District of State aforesaid on both sides of Peters Creek on the South Side of Enoree River & on the North side of Gilders Creek including the Plantation whereon Henry J. Walker now lives, beginning on a Beachs Corner a little below Peters Creek on Enoree River, thence rising the hill to a Corner poplar, thence to a Corner Black oak on Gilders Creek, thence up the Meanders of the Creek to said Moons line, thence along said Moons line to Enoree River, thence down the said River on its meanders to the beginning, which includes the full land to be conveyed be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Moon his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this fiftenth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and two. & in the Twenty fourth year of American Independence —
