

This Indenture made the fifteenth day of July in the year of Lord One thousand seven hundred and ninety nine between John Campbell of the County of Greenville & St. of South Carolina of the one part and Paul Abner of the other part of County and State aforesaid Witnesses, that the said John Campbell for and in consideration of the sum of ten dollars to him in hand paid by s^r. Paul Abner the Receipt hereof is hereby acknowledged to the s^r. John Campbell hath bargained and sold, and by these Presents doth bargain and sell unto the s^r. Paul Abner a certain Tract or Parcel of Land Containing to twelve Acres, more or less beginning on a maple where Paul Abners line crosses the branch that Isaac Norman formerly lived on, running up the branch to the head from thence a condition Blue to said Abners line for complement with all and every of its appurtenances to the s^r. John Campbell doth from himself, & his heirs and from all and every other Person & Persons with warrant and for ever defend to the said Paul Abner his heirs and assigns for ever. in Witness whereof the s^r. John Campbell hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day & year above written. Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence of Edward Carter Peter Carter John Campbell
