Carolina & District of Greenville of the One part and Lewis Land  
of the State and District aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the  
said Moses Land for the Consideration of the sum of One hundred  
dollars paid by the said Lewis Land the Receipt whereof is hereby  
Acknowledged that I the said Moses Land have granted bargained  
and sold unto the said Lewis Land part of a Tract of land originally  
granted to Old M. Turnbow lying on the Waters of Enore River  
beginning at a black Jack Corner, from thence along the old line to a  
Pine, thence along said old line to a black Oak, thence across to  
the beginning the same containing One hundred Acres to the same  
more or less, and I the said Moses Land warrant and for ever defend  
the above mentioned Tract of Land to the said Lewis Land his heirs  
and assigns from me my heirs Executors Adm<sup>rs</sup> & assigns for ever.
