that I Lewis Landreth of the State and District aforesaid for and in
consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars to paid
in hand the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained
and sold and by these Presents do grant bargain and sell unto Thomas
Springfield his heirs &c one certain tract or parcel of land containing
one hundred acres be the same more or less lying and being in
the County and State aforesaid it being the tract or parcel of land
that John Landreth sold to Lewis Landreth and all the said tract
that lies the south side of Moore River, and bound by the line, &
marked trees, waters and water courses mentioned in the deed given me
by William Tubb, Containing as a hundred acres more or less.

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments to said land
& premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to the said
Thomas Springfield his heirs and assigns forever, and I do for my part
warrant and defend a good and lawful title to said land & premises
against the claim of myself and my heirs and all other claims whatso-
ever claiming it or any part thereof. in witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this 13th day of September eighteen hundred and three
